

Kenya Horticultural Project Goes for Suzuki TF 125 Bikes



Eight Suzuki TF 125 motorbikes were handed over by Car & General Sales Manager (Suzuki), Peter Mwaura to the Kenya Horticulture Competitiveness Project (KHCP). This is a five-year USAID funded initiative launched in 2010. It aims to benefit over 200,000 smallholder farmers with more income, better food security, and improved nutrition.

The handover took place on 11th August 2011 James Muli Masinga's Farm Sultan Hamud, Eastern Province. The farm, chosen by KHCP as a learning site for farmers, demonstrates low cost green housing, water harvesting from a bore hole for irrigation of paw paw, capsicum and water melons under drip irrigation. The bikes will be used by the project's field officers.
